

FIGHT OR FLIGHT?



HOW HAS MY CHILDHOOD INFLUENCED WHO AND HOW I AM TODAY?














This is a photo I love because it is me and my mum in front of Sydney Opera house, a place I love with someone I love.




This is a photo of my puppy, Roo. I love this photo so much and it reminds me of how gorgeous and special she is.






This is a photo of me, my mum, my dad and sister. I love this photo because it brings back special memories of my prom day and is my favourite photo of us all together.




This is a photo from the internet. I love it because it is so beautiful and I love the colours.


AMI STRUCTURE?

HANNAH












WHAT DO I STAND FOR?



Fashion for Bank Robbers






EDEN LOWETH




